

## What does my child need?

When your child comes to the kindergarten, it needs the following things:

- cuddly toy (if needed)
- indoor shoes
- breakfast/afternoon snack
- mud trousers/raincoat/wellington boots
- change of clothing



## What does the kindergarten need?

The kindergarten needs the following from you:

- telephone number at which the kindergarten can **always** contact someone in an emergency
- entitlement to pick the child up (who is allowed to pick the child up?)

You will receive further information in a personal discussion with the trained pedagogic staff.



## How do the first few days at the day nursery run?

In order to make your child's acclimatization at the kindergarten as pleasant as possible, it is done individually. Acclimatization by the hour is done step by step in order to acclimatize your child to the environment and the new people.

Involving a parent/trusted attachment figure is an integral part.

As soon as a strengthened trust relationship to the trained pedagogic staff has been built up, the children remain in the kindergarten without accompaniment of the parents/attachment person.



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## What do I have to observe?

When your child comes to the kindergarten, hand him/her over to the responsible worker.

Your child is only allowed to go to the kindergarten if he/she is free of contagious diseases.

If your child is ill, please phone the kindergarten and report that the child is ill.
