The maximum quantity per delivery and waste type is 1m³ (exception: maximum 0.5m³ of residual waste). Organic waste will not be collected.

Bulky waste

Large and other objects that do not fit into the refuse bin due to their size.



Registering is easy

Please register at least three weeks in advance in writing by completing the bulky waste card on the household refuse collection calendar. The first collection of the year is made per household free of charge. Further collections can be made for a fee. Only cards from the current calendar year are valid. The contracted company shall inform you three to four days in advance of the collection date.

This includes:

Floor coverings and carpets, fridges and freezers, furniture, large and small electrical appliances, metals,

This doesn't include:

Asbestos-containing waste, building rubble, car parts, cardboard boxes, mirrors, paint buckets, problematic substances, refuse bags, sheet glass, waste from modification and renovation

Hazardous waste collection

20kg per waste type will be collected free of charge.



- Ganderkesee: Weststr. 10, near the composting plant
- Neerstedt: Kirchhatter Str. 8, waste transfer station
- Wardenburg: Rothenschlatt industrial park

Special vehicles provide a mobile collection twice a year. The collection points and times are printed on the household refuse collection calendar on pages 41 and 42.

Green waste

Tree / shrub cuttings and garden waste can be disposed of at the appropriate collection points for a fee.

- Ganderkesee: Weststr. 10, composting plant, Weststraße
- Großenkneten: Sage, Sager Str. / Am Waldesrand
- Hatten: Sandkruger Str.
- Hude: Leckerhörne, next to the wastewater treatment plant
- Kirchseele: Wiesenweg
- Wardenburg: Charlottendorf-West, An der Bäke
- Wildeshausen: Bargloy, next to the old landfill
